#### **December Notice**

The events and activities for December 2022-23 school year are listed below, please read carefully.

(1) Music Day

In order to express our concern for those in need in the society, the school responded to The


Community Chest by holding a charity event "Dress casual Day" on <u>21<sup>st</sup> December 2022</u>
