October Notice

The events and activities for October 2022-23 school year are listed below, please read carefully.

(1) Preparation for the resumption of classes

According to the latest guidelines of the Education Bureau (EDB) if individual schools plan to resume face-to-face classes for the whole school or individual class levels on or after 1 November 2022, students who have received three doses vaccine. The 3 dose vaccination requirement for participating in the other half-day for non-academic extra-curricular activities and Sports Day will be implemented earlier on October 1. If your child had already received 3 doses of vaccination, please hand in a copy of the vaccination record to the class teacher to provide the school with accurate data to prepare for the resumption of full day face-to-face classes or scheduling of learning activities in the afternoon.

(2) National Day Holiday and Double Ninth Festival Holiday

1 October 2022 (Saturday) is the National Day Holiday. 4 October 2022 (Tuesday) is the Double Ninth Festival Holiday.

(3) School Sports Day

This school year Sports Day will be held on 11,12 October 2022 (Tuesday & Wednesday). Details and notes for students are as follow:

Venue	Sham Shui Po Sports Ground
Registration time	8:00 A.M (Students should take attendance with their student ID cards)



Notes for Students:

1. The annual Sports Day is a school-wide event with profound educational significance and all students must attend.
2. Vaccine Pass: According to the latest guidelines of the Education Bureau students who participate in the Sports Day should have received three doses of vaccine if not students **are not allow to enter the venue** and they are require to stay at school and finish their homework.
3. If a student asks for leave due to personal business, one must have a parent's letter and apply to the class teacher at least one day before. Those who are absent due to illness are required to submit a sick leave certificate. Those who do not follow the above procedures and are absent will be consider as truancy.
4. When students enter the venue, they must show their student ID cards to the staff to take attendance and must show the **Vaccine Pass [blue code]** and the **rapid antigen test record** form (with the parent signature on the day). Hand over their mobile phone (if any) to the teacher for safekeeping during the assembly.
5. Students' uniform and grooming requirement should be the same as normal school day. All students (including cheerleaders) must wear school uniforms or the school's sports uniforms (cheerleaders should change their uniform after entering the stadium). Coats that do not conform to the regulations will be prohibited from being brought into the venue and will be detained for violations.
6. Cameras (except staffs), radios, tape recorders, turntables, comics, magazines, newspapers, MP3 players, electronic gaming devices and all items not related to the day are not allowed to enter the venue. If found, it will be kept by the school.
7. It is forbidden to bring or chew gums (chewing-gums) in the venue. Gambling, drinking, smoking, playing and chasing are strictly prohibited.
8. The order in the venue is maintained by the school uniformed troops and prefects. All students must obey the instructions of the staff.



9. Students should keep the venue clean and tidy. Assist in the cleaning of the stands before leaving the venue.
10. Cherish the school reputation, respect yourself and pay attention to personal words and deeds. Do not carry valuables or large amounts of money and cross the road carefully to avoid accidents.

(4) Holiday after the day of Sports Day

13 October 2022 (Thursday) is the holiday after Sports Day, students do not need to go to school.

(5) Teacher Development Day (1)

24 October 2022 (Monday) is the Teacher Development Day, students should study at home do not need to go to the school.

(6) 1st Semester Uniform Test

1st Semester uniform test will be held on 25 October 2022 – 28 October 2022 (Tuesday to Friday), the detail of the uniform test will be distributed soon.

(7) Blood Donation Day

Hong Kong needs to collect 650 packs of blood every day to ensure the blood supply of all hospitals in Hong Kong and save patients who need blood transfusion. The school will hold a blood donation day on 1 November 2022 (Tuesday). Blood donors must be at least 16 years old on the blood donation day. Participants under the age of 18 must submit a parental consent form issued by the Red Cross.

(8) Arrangement of Students Health Service

Due to the evolving COVID-19 situation and the need to mobilize staff to participate in disease prevention and control, in 2022/2023 school year the Department of Health had decided to provide Students Health Service to students in Secondary 1 - 3 only.
