December Notice

The events and activities for the December 2025-26 school year are listed below. Please read carefully.

(1) Class Photo and Uniform Group Photo Shooting

Class photos and uniform group photos will be taken on **December 1st, 2025 (Monday)**. All students must wear a complete winter school uniform back to school. If there is a PE lesson on that day, please bring along the PE uniform.

(2) S 5 Citizenship and Social Development Zhuhai Field Trip

The Citizenship and Social Development Department will organize a 2-day, 1-night field trip to Zhuhai for Secondary 5 students on December 4 and 5.

All participating students must assemble at the school playground before 7:30 a.m. on December 4th.

Parents are requested to remind students to bring their Hong Kong Identity Cards and Home Return Permits. Safety and serious learning are the top priorities during the field trip. Students must follow the instructions of team leaders and teachers and strictly abide by laws and regulations. (3) Day Holiday after Legislative Council Election

December 8, 2025 (Monday) is the holiday following the Legislative Council Election. Students do not need to return to school and should stay home for self-study.

(4) "Mindful Breathing and Stretching" Parents' Workshop

Our school will hold the "Mindful Breathing and Stretching Parents' Workshop" on **December 16, 2025 (Tuesday)**. Through mindfulness, breathing, stretching, and flexibility exercises, the workshop aims to provide parents with a moment of relaxation and peace. Registration is currently open. (5) Parent-Child Christmas Luncheon

The "Parent-Child Christmas Luncheon", organized by the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA), will be held on **December 19th, 2025 (Friday)**. Parents, students, and relatives are cordially invited to participate and enjoy a warm afternoon together. For details of the activity, please refer to the notice issued on November 21.

(6) Christmas Thanksgiving Prayer Service and Christmas Celebration Activities

The Christmas Thanksgiving Prayer Service is scheduled to be held on December 22, 2025 (Monday). Students should return to school in their complete winter school uniform as usual before 7:55 a.m. No textbooks are required. Students may leave school to return home at around 12:00 noon.

(7) Casual Wear Day

To support the Community Chest, our school will hold a "Casual Wear Day" charity event on **December 22, 2025 (Monday)**. Students who make a donation may wear casual wear back to school on that day. All donations collected will be fully donated to the Community Chest for social welfare purposes. We hope parents will encourage their children to actively support and participate in community service. The arrangements are as follows:

1. Students who donate **\$20 or more** may wear neat and decent casual wear back to school (identified by a donation label). They can also choose to wear a complete school uniform.
2. Once donated, the funds are non-refundable.
3. Participants should dress in a simple and decent manner, avoiding eccentric or bizarre styles. If a student's casual wear does not comply with school regulations, the school will follow up in accordance with the "School Uniform and Grooming" rules.

Casual Wear Dress Code Standards:

- i. No tank tops, revealing clothes, midriff-baring tops, or low-cut tops.
- ii. No short shorts or short skirts.
- iii. Sneakers or leather shoes are allowed; no slippers/slides.
- iv. Grooming requirements are the same as regular school days: no hair dyeing, makeup, nail polish, or jewelry/accessories.



(8) Launch of "SPARK English AI Platform."

To further enhance students' comprehensive English listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills, the school will launch the "SPARK English AI Platform" this academic year. The relevant arrangements are notified as follows:

Project Objectives:

Strengthen students' proficiency in the four major English domains (reading, writing, listening, speaking) through personalized, data-driven, and instant-feedback learning methods.

Improve students' self-directed learning motivation and efficiency, and assist teachers in understanding learning progress and needs.

Encourage students to use the relevant AI platform frequently and effectively. Students from all grade levels can use this platform to hone their English grammar skills, and Secondary 6 students can further use it to prepare for public examinations.

Platform Introduction (Four-in-One AI English Platform):

The "SPARK English AI Platform" integrates four major sub-platforms to provide a one-stop learning experience:

EB (Reading): Reading comprehension and vocabulary expansion, recommending articles according to students' levels, and providing comprehension exercises and analysis.

OWL (Writing): Writing training and instant feedback, covering grammar, structure, word choice, and essay organization.

ListenUp (Listening): Multi-scenario listening materials and training, with word-by-word transcripts and key point prompts.

SpeakTime (Speaking): Oral practice and grading feedback, supporting situational dialogue, pronunciation, and fluency analysis.



Activation Time:

The platform is scheduled to officially open for use on December 1.

Account & Login Information:

Class teachers will distribute individual student login details (account and initial password) to all students before November 28. Parents are requested to supervise students to keep them safe and follow instructions to complete the first login and reset the password.

Demonstration:

Subject teachers will demonstrate platform operations and learning workflows in class to familiarize students with platform functions and learning requirements.
