### **June Notice**

The events and activities for June 2025-26 are listed below. Please read carefully.

#### **(1) Teacher Professional Development Day (III)**

**June 3, 2026 (Wednesday)** is the Teacher Professional Development Day. Students do not need to return to school for classes and should study at home.

#### **(2) Second Semester Exam**

The Second Semester Examination for S1 to S5 students will be held from **June 4 to June 15, 2026**. Please refer to the "2025-26 Second Semester Examination" notice issued on May 14, 2026, for detailed exam arrangements. Starting from **May 26, 2026 (Tuesday)**, all extracurricular activities and remedial classes will be suspended, except for those led by tutors. Students should return home directly after school to study.

#### **(3) Exam Paper Checking**

**June 24, 2026 (Wednesday) and June 25, 2026 (Thursday)** are the Exam Paper Checking Days.

All students must wear a neat summer school uniform and return to school **on or before 7:55 a.m.**, then report to their classrooms according to the "Exam Paper Checking Timetable" (Appendix 1).

Attendance on these days will be counted towards school attendance records.

#### **(4) Post-Exam Class Arrangements**

After the completion of the Second Semester Examination, students are only required to return to school on designated dates to attend school-wide/grade-wide activities (such as Exam Paper Checking, Senior Secondary Remedial Classes, Year-end Ceremony, etc.). For the remaining days, students should attend post-exam activities according to their individual registrations.



**(5) 2025-26 Year-end Ceremony**

This year's Year-end Ceremony will be held on the morning of **July 13, 2026 (Monday)** in the School Hall. Students must wear neat summer school uniform and return to school by **7:55 p.m.** as usual.

After the ceremony, students may leave school at **11:30 a.m.** In case of school suspension announced by the Education Bureau due to rainstorms or typhoons, the ceremony will be postponed to **July 14, 2026 (Tuesday)**.

**(6) Post-Exam Activities**

The post-exam activities for the 2025-26 academic year have been scheduled. Parents are requested to discuss with their children and choose suitable activities from the "2025-26 Post-Exam Activities List" (Appendix 2) to help students make good use of their leisure time and broaden their horizons. Students should sign up directly with the teacher-in-charge of the respective activities. Individual parent notification letters will be issued for specific activities. As places are limited, students are encouraged to seize the opportunity.
